#### **General Management Track**

The major objective of the general management track is to train broadly competent administrators for service in a wide variety of organizations – public or private, product- or service-oriented, profit or not-for-profit. To accomplish this basic objective, the program offers the student the opportunity to acquire knowledge about the management of human and physical resources and to acquire skills useful in the management of any organization.

- 12 hours of upper-division coursework in Management (MAN)\*\*
  - \*\* Please note that practicum courses (Management 347P, 366P, 367P, 369P) may be used to satisfy a management elective or the BBA experiential learning requirement, but one class may not be used to satisfy both.

#### **Consulting and Change Management Track**

The consulting and change management track is designed to prepare students to become leaders in consulting firms, firms which require consulting advice, and firms implementing important changes. Consulting processes often involve extensive analyses of the firm's competitive position, capabilities, organizational processes, culture, etc. Once a new direction is developed the process of implementing the changes must be managed. Examples of such changes include introducing new competitive thrusts, revised organizational structures, new technologies, and expansion into new geographic markets.
