UT RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS

"In residence" refers to courses taken at UT Austin; it does not include credit-by-exam, extension, or distance education courses. All of the following must be completed in residence:

- At least two long semesters or an equivalent period of time.
- A total of 60 hours.
- 24 hours in business, on a letter-grade basis.
- 12 upper-division hours, on a letter-grade basis, from the major coursework.

Core Curriculum

All students pursuing an undergraduate degree at the University must complete the forty-two-hour statewide core curriculum. The list of courses students should choose from to fulfill their core requirements is updated annually and published in the General Information Catalog. Students should consult the Course Schedule in order to see the core course offerings in any given semester.
